



CASH PAYMENTS NO LONGER ACCEPTED

September 18, 2015

Good Day

Effective October 13, 2015, the Customs Department will only be taking Debit, Credit and Cheque payments. We will not be accepting any cash payment in Providenciales and Grand Turk Customs Department.

All cash payments will be paid at the Government Treasury in both islands.

All entries will have to be screened, checked and vouchers will be created for payment at the Customs main office for payment at the Treasury.

After payment, importers will have to report to Customs main offices for selectivity clearance checks of entries before goods can be received at the port of pick up.

If this is not done the officers at these stations will not release cargo to any importer because trigger selectivity is done on declaration.

All Customs Airports, Harbour-Master offices (Docks), Anti Smuggling unit transactions will remain the same.
